Call to Order

The application of Daniel Brown, property owner to install a replacement fence located at 27 Main Street, (Map 050, Lot 009) in the Town Center District.

- D. Brown approached the HDC and described that he would like to replace a rotting picket fence with a cedar, sainted white, picket fence spanning roughly 92 linear fee that would be 54 inches high. It will be constructed of 2x2s. The pickets will be slightly bigger than they currently are, and instead of a singular rail that hold the pickets, it will be a sandwich rail.
- T. Cook clarified that the side fence would remain the same, but that the front would be replaced.

Brief discussion took place that since it was wood, and considering other fences in the area, that it would be an okay replacement for the Historic District.
